and is reported: on rolls from enlistment to Aug 31/64
present: Sept + Oct 1864 absent on detached
service: Nov + Dec 1864 absent sick from
wound received Dec 1st 1864 (Company was
engaged in action said date on Wilsons ^{Leggs} Creek)
Same report to June 30th 1865, + same re-
port on Company Muster out roll dated
August 28th 1865.

Final Statement shows him died while on Furlough
from Chittenden Hosp^t Louisville Ky July 26th 1865;
from Gunshot Fracture Right Clavicle Middle
third.
