A. **ALMONRODE** received 5 votes

J. J. **BOYER** received 1 vote

Samuel **SELLERS** received 1 vote

J. M. **DEAN** received 1 vote

CREEKMEN received 1 vote

ALMONRODE having received a majority of all the votes cast was declared elected.

Motion made and seconded that all the other old officers would stand as they was by a unanimous vote of the Post.

There being no further business Post adjourned in regular form.
