




of the sorting and barreling. There were around 25 workers in one average size orchard.

One apple tree would bear an average of 15-20 bushel. Some as high as 30 bushel per tree in a good year.

A good picker would pick 100 to 150 bushel per day. Everett **Lewis** is said to have held the record for picking in Clay County at 254 bushel in one day.

Forty eight trees were usually set per acre and a yeild of 8 to 10 bushel per tree was needed to make a profit. In checking with a local fruit grower today, they reportedly harvest from 10 to 12 bushel per tree.
