**HENKE, Balzer, arrived as a minor, petition date Nov 3, 1904**

**KRUTSINGER, Simeon, Witness**

**PHILLIPS, L.C., Witness**

**HENKE renounced allegiance to Germany**

**Petitioner has resided in US for 43 years**

**PETERS, Detlef, 1st petition 4/7/1900, Marion Co. IL**

**MOORE, F. R., Witness**

**SONGER, John, Witness**

**PETERS denounced allegiance to The Emperor of Germany**

**Final Naturalization date October 4, 1904**

As far as we know, this is the last of the naturalization records at the Courthouse. Below is an example of an Oath of Allegiance found in a prior record.

I do solemnly swear that I will support the Constitution of the United States and that I hereby renounce all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign prince, potentate, state or sovereignty whatever, and more particularly all allegiance and fidelity to Queen Victoria wherof I have heretofore been a subject.
