Pheobe Winchester

died prior to the 1860 Census leaving two small boys

1860 Census shows her sons John and William Aldridge  
in the home of Jason Winchester her parents.

- iv. Uriah C. Winchester, born 1839 in NC; died February 01, 1863 in Bowling Green Ky.

Notes for Uriah C. Winchester:

Uriah C. Winchester served in the Civil War, Company C 98th Ill Vol Inf.

joined Aug 7 1862 Wilder's Brigade

died of Erysipelas (a disease of the skin caused by streptococcus and marked by spreading  
inflammation and fever) Feb. 1 1863 at Bowling Green, KY. convalescent Barracks

this compiler has his military record

Blue eyes, brown hair, 5'6" tall age 23 when he entered service Aug 1862

- v. Martha Jane Winchester, born October 26, 1841 in TN; died February 11, 1911 in Clay County  
Illinois; married Isaac J. Fancher August 19, 1863 in Probably Clay County Illinois.

Notes for Martha Jane Winchester:

Martha Jane Winchester buried at Keen Chapel Cemetery Clay County Illinois

- vi. Thomas J Winchester, born 1843 in Tn; married Louisa Hays March 10, 1864.  
vii. Alexander A Winchester, born 1846 in Smith County Tn; died January 21, 1908 in Iola Clay  
County Illinois; married Jane Ann Robison March 29, 1868 in Iola Clay County Illinois; born  
August 29, 1851 in Switzerland County Ind; died September 02, 1929 in Broken Bow Neb.

Notes for Alexander A Winchester:

Alexander A. Winchester, born Smith County TN

birth year maybe 1845 or 1846 ( military record shows age 18 in May 1864 when he joined Co D,  
143 Illinois Vol Inf. showed Oskaloosa, Clay Co. Illinois as

residence served until Sept 26, 1864. served 100 days as musician

Blue eyes, Black Hair, 5'5" tall

resided in Nebraska

on census—year? as "Eleazer"

Alexander died on a visit to see family in Iola, Illinois a few days between his and his sister

Racheal Emmiline (Winchester) Rodgers, Killingsworth (Jan 1908 at Iola, Larkinsburg Twp.,  
Clay County) his body was taken back to his home state of Nebraska for burial at Anselmo

- viii. Zelean Francis Winchester, born 1848 in Tn.

- ix. John W. Winchester, born May 03, 1853; died April 20, 1920; married Delila Fair Eytchison

Notes for John W. Winchester:

John W. Winchester's death certificate showed father name as "Chaseya" this is Jason Winchester  
on land records in Illinois 1852 and 1858 and probate 1861 Clay County Illinois

buried Newton Chapel Blair Twp Clay County Illinois
