Dec 4, 1908, Order for 2 witnesses showing whether claimant & soldier lived together from their marriage April 27, 1890 to his death August 17, 1908.

Nov 14, 1908, Amanda HILLIBRAND, claimant, age 40 years-she owns no stocks-bond-mortgages nor interest in stocks, bonds, mortgages or moneys of any kind. She can earn about \$100 per year. Household goods are worth about \$25.00.

Jan 18, 1909, Sent to Dept.

Mar 3, 1909, J.C.?????, age 70, many years before April 28, 1865, knew him since 1862. He was single, would have knew if he had been married before 1865.

Sent to dept.

Amanda HILLIBRAND-age 41 years-PO Noble. She has made diligent inquiry to get someone to testify to the death of Martha in 1870 in MO, Harrison County, has failed,

she now therefore relies on the statement of said soldier, David N. HILLIBRAND, first wife

was Lillie COURTRIGHT. She died in 1852 or 1853 at Stros? County. Rebecca, his 2nd

wife died in 1866, his 3rd wife died in 1870, Martha CONAWAY. Rebecca's affidavit says he left her about May 10, 1890. Got up, eat his breakfast with us and told me he was a going to leave, one, because I did not want him to drink liquor to get

drunk,

we had no falling out. Did not separate by agreement. We cohabited together until he

left. I never referred to -----myself to him.

Nov 13, 1909, Amanda says home at Richland(Co) from 1870 to-----

Dec. 13, 1909, Sent letter and 30 cts in stamps to L. MANUELL for a certificate as to any divorce suit filed in said court Aug 13, 1910, Sent letter to the commissioner.

Nov 16, 1910, notice that the claim was sent to the examiner in Richland County to examine, sent letter to claimant.

Dec 16, 1910, Sent letter to the commissioner.

Feb 7, 1911, received check for \$10.00

Feb 10, 1911, Money order for \$5.00
