

## MILITARY PENSION REQUESTS

- Nov 5, 1908, John MARTIN, county clerk, Olney, Illinois certifies:  
David N. HILLIBRAND was married to Miss Amanda FRYMAN in said  
county April 27, 1890 by Herman DAVIS, Justice of the Peace.
- ROGERS, Lydia N, Noble, ILL., age 55  
Feb 11, 1909, acquainted with him ever since April 27, 1890.  
They were man & wife until August 17, 1908, when he died and  
was not divorced. Have good reason to believe if they had been  
divorced I would have "knew" it.
- SMITH, Perry, age 71 years  
Oct 8m 1909, Perry SMITH says that Lillie HILLIBRAND, his first wife, died in  
1852 or 1853
- TRUITT, A. L., age 65 years  
Nov 13, 1909, David N. HILLIBRAND came here about 1887 and  
remained here until April 22, 1890. He made his home at Clay County  
and Richland County. He represented that he has not after 1870. ???
- TRUITT, Elizabeth, age 62  
Nov 13, 1909, joins her husband in his testimony
- TRUITT, John C, age 69  
Nov 2, 1908, Personally know that Amanda HILLIBRAND for  
30 years and ever since she was of marriageable age. Her  
maiden name was Amanda FRYMAN. Her first and only  
marriage was to David N. HILLIBRAND, April 27, 1890.  
Nov 5, 1908, Sent above to Dept.
- HOLMAN, Samuel, Pvt Co I 63rd Regt ILL Vols, age 69  
Now draws \$14.00 per month. Chronic Diarrhea and disease of  
stomach and heart. Cert No. 432-452. That said Chronic Diarrhea  
has increased since November the 6, 1907, and resulted constipation.  
Liver trouble and diabetes, disease of stomach has increased. Heart  
disease has increased. Independent of any other disease to disqualify  
him from gaining a substinance for manual labor, totally and equal to the  
loss of hand or foot and entitled to \$24 per month.  
Jan 8, 1909, Sent same to Dept.  
Feb 5, 1909, Order for medical examination. Cert #432-452 Co I 63rd  
Regiment Ills inf. vol.  
Feb 10, 1909, examined at Flora by E W BOYLES, Geo W STEELEY and  
E C PARK.  
Mar 17, 1909, Claim rejected, a pension in excess of \$14 per month is not  
warranted  
for pensioned cause, chronic diarrhea and disease of stomach and heart.  
Died April 23rd, A.D. 1909, was buried Sunday Aapril 25 in the IOOF Cemetery.
- BRISSENDEN, Morris, age 80 years  
May 5, 1909, same testimony as VISHNISKKI affidavit.  
Sent to dept.
- HOLMAN, Clemence, widow of Samuel HOLMAN, age 59 yrs.
