Died April 23rd 1909, at Clay City.

VISHNISKI, Thomas, neighbor, age 67 yrs.

WALTON, Dr J W, age 39 years

Have treated him for stomach, heart, liver and bowel trouble.

He is kept upon a restricted diet all the time. He suffers from liver  
trouble causing-----constipation. Liver, stomach and bowel  
trouble has resulted in diabetes mellitus of the very worst form,  
causing a gradual reduction of bodily weight and strength. His  
heart trouble is gradually getting worse and only a slight exertion  
causes palpitation of same, in fact he is in such a condition that  
death is liable to follow from heart trouble at any time. His  
disability is equal to the loss of hand or foot. By reference to my  
books I find he was treated for above disease on the following  
dates: Jan 19, 1908, March 5, 1908, June 12, 1908, Oct 26, 1908, January 13,  
1909.

January 18, 1909, Sent same to Dept.

HOWELL, Samuel, Pvt. Co I 62nd Regt IND Vols, age 64

Aug 27, 1910, in war of 1861, Civil War, now payable at the  
Chicago pension agency at the rate of \$17 per month under  
certificate No 219645, makes his application for increase.

Oct 1, 1910, sent letter to Samuel HOWELL about his claim.

Jul 31, 1910, sent letter to HOWELL

PARKER, C. C. Jr. MD, age 37 years

Aug 26, 1910, I have this day examined him and find his  
general physical condition not good. The skin is pale and  
muscles are flabby and thin is evacuation(emaciated?)  
and general disability. Examination of lungs shows only  
two inch extension of chest forced expiration-----  
and full inspiration 38 inches. On-----there is dullness  
and aches of both lungs and -----murrels(?) both dry and  
moist values over part of murmur are a part of both lungs.
