ILLS Jan 20, 1866, Catherine died November 23rd, 1883.  
David RALEY again married Mary E. COIL June 22, 1884, at  
Clay County. They lived together until his death Sept 13, 1909.

James Y. COIL at Shelby County, MO.  
James Y. COIL died April 16, 1881 at Fulton, MO, insane.

HUDSON, Anne E, age 50 years, St. Elmo, IL  
Sept 27, 1909, Her first marriage to James Y. COIL was March or April 1873.  
COIL died in the -----April 16, 1881. She remained a widow until  
June 22, 1884, when she married David RALEY before personal knowledge  
acquainted with faintly before first marriage in March or April 1873.

LEWIS, James R, age 71  
Sept 20, 1909, I have known RALEYS ever since 1856. Knew  
his first marriage was to Catherine JONES and that she died  
Nov 23, 1883, 2nd marriage was to Mary E. COIL, June 22, 1884.  
They lived together until RALEY died Sept 13, 1909.  
Sept 22, 1909, sent to the dept all of the above  
Sept 28, 1909, notice claim received  
Sept 23, 1909, act April 19, 1908, No 927-650

RUBINS, George H, Pvt Co I 175 Ohio Vols, age 66  
Chicago Agency, rate \$17 per month, Certificate No. 286-183, now  
pensioned for rheumatism-neuralgia, result heart disease. Claim increase  
disabled for manual labor with heart disease, rheumatism-neuralgia and  
stomach. That said diseases increases as grows older his condition grows  
worse. He therefore requests another examination that he may be rated  
at \$24 per month according to the Degree of Disability under the law.
